Interview

Spencer says everyone is talking about climate change. Spencer introduces Bruce Cooke, electrical engineer and practicing Anglican who is heading up EcoChurch, a project to build sustainability in church communities. Cooke says the church is installing a water tank and recycling, and asking parishioners to pledge to make environmental choices. Cooke says it's about reading Genesis afresh and understanding that we're "caretakers of the environment". Cooke says there are other parishes "taking up the challenge" as well. Cooke says there is plenty of discussion about the initiatives within his church. Cooke says their parish priest is going to ask the local political candidates what are their plans to tackle climate change as well as other issues.
